Setting up of Counter Insurgency and Anti Terrorist Schools (CIATSs)

In order to strength the training inputs in the States affected by insurgency and terrorism, during the 11th Plan period a scheme was approved for establishment of 20 Counter Insurgency and Anti Terrorist Schools (CIATSs) four each in the States of Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand and Orissa at the cost of `52.40 crores. In these Schools 75,000 police personnel were likely to get trained for combating terrorism/Naxalism. The proposed trainings mainly are outdoor and do not require large scale permanent constructions. Most of the required infrastructure is temporary. The contribution of this Ministry towards the Scheme is to provide funds mainly for establishment of CIAT Schools, recurring expenditure thereon and for equipment upgradation. The land for these schools is to be provided by the concerned State Governments. They are also to provide administrative support for running the CIAT Schools. BPR&D is to sign the MOUs to this effect with respective State.

<u>5. Current Status</u>: At present, twelve CIAT Schools are operational in the States. Construction in One CIAT School in Orissa has already been completed and training will start from July 2011. Remaining 07 CIAT Schools are under construction; two in Jharkhand and one each in Chhattisgarh, West Bengal, Nagaland, Tripura and Manipur. The State Govt. has utilised Rs. 20 Crore so far for construction of CIAT Schools. The Ministry is going to release funds of Rs. 5 Crore to the State Govt. in respect of functional CIAT Schools (except functional Schools in Assam) for equipment upgradation / upgradation of the CIAT Schools. So far more than 7000 police personnel got training in these CIAT Schools.
